Learning Out and About and in School

Sport at Marlborough School

We know that in order to create happy, resilient learners we need healthy, active children. We provide children with many opportunities to be active throughout the school day, with movement forming aspects of learning throughout our curriculum. Our Reception children rarely stop and are on the move in all their learning! Our children have **high quality PE lessons**, with progression being assessed through the *Get Set for PE* programme. Every PE lesson has a clear learning objective and a Learning Power linked to one of our 6 R's. All children know how they can challenge themselves in PE. Across the year, children are taught by a range of **PE specialists**: Plymouth Argyle and Vicky Pryer. We also complete a 'Marlborough 10' each day, with all classes taking part in a keep fit focused 10-minute activity. We have **active playtimes**, with quality equipment available for children to use, such as hula hoops, skipping ropes and bean bags. We have **Packet Tournaments** each half term, enabling children to develop skills and work with older and younger children. We run **extra-curricular sports clubs**: netball, football, multi-sports and a **NEW running club**, which started this week. Mr Swiggs, Miss Tremewan and Mrs Bridges form part of the new Marlborough Running Club and children will have the opportunity to run around the local area during Monday lunch times. We have started with Class 6 who set an impressive pace this week!
