Learning Out and About and In School

Class 1 Into the Woods – Class 1 are heading into Prislow Woods today to start their *Into The Woods* topic. They will be back in time for lunch.

Class 6 to Pendennis Castle – Class 6 will be attending a workshop at Pendennis Castle on Wednesday 22nd September. They will be looking at how the castle has been used over time, with a focus on World War 2.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

Mobile Phones and Safeguarding

In order to keep our children safe from inappropriate images and communication we are asking parents to delay the influence of mobile phones for children for as long as possible. Children in Class 6 are able to bring phones to school if they walk home alone but these need to be handed into the school office as they enter the school site. Parents of children in Class 5 can talk to Mrs Gall if there is a need for their child to bring a mobile phone to school. Again, these need to be kept in the school office during the school day.

Covid Updates

As Cornwall and Devon are currently *Enhanced Response Areas* we are continuing with many of our Covid safety measures until the notice has been removed. This means that we are asking parents to drop their children off at their classroom doors and collect them from the playgrounds. We are also asking adults to wear masks on the school site. Many thanks for your cooperation with these measures.

Contingency Plan – We have devised a Contingency Plan in case we need to return to remote learning. This can be found on our website alongside our Covid risk assessment.

Isolation – The rules for covid isolation have changed. If you have Covid symptoms you need a PCR from the test site and isolate until your test results are back. If you have a positive result you need to isolate but the other members of the household can carry on as normal if they are under 18 or are fully vaccinated.

Attendance

As children under 18 do not need to isolate if they come into contact with someone with a positive Covid result, the expectation is that children continue to attend school. Our Education Welfare Officer supports us by identifying pupils whose attendance drops below 95% and looking at ways that we can increase attendance.




