Covid Cases, Symptoms and Testing

Please get a PCR test as soon as possible if you have any of these symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Please note: A lateral flow test should not be used if you are displaying symptoms; the person with symptoms should take a PCR test. You and anyone you live with should stay at home until you get your test result. Only leave your home to have a test. Anyone in your childcare or support bubble should also stay at home if you have been in close contact with them since your symptoms started or during the 48 hours before they started. Please continue to inform the office if your child shows symptoms of Covid-19, is being tested, is awaiting a test result and the outcome of the test. Please continue to inform the office if someone in your household has symptoms and the result of the Covid test. All household members need to isolate if someone displays symptoms.

Safety Measures for Sports Day Sessions

- Two classes maximum on the school field with social distancing between the two classes.
- Classes and spectators will be kept on separate sides of the school field.
- Spectators will be able to enter the school field 15 minutes before the start of each session.
- Spectators will need to be seated during the session.
- Spectators will sit in groups with a maximum of 30 people with distancing between household groups.
- The names and phone numbers of spectators will be noted to enable us to track and trace should a member of the group develop Covid symptoms.
- If anyone within the group becomes positive all members of the group will be contacted to isolate.
- Masks will need to be worn when spectators are walking around the field. They can be removed once seated.
- DO NOT ATTEND if you have symptoms of Covid or you are isolating due to close contact with Covid.

Online Safety

We are aware that some of our children are having friendship issues due to communication that is happening through technology outside of the school day. Please monitor your child's communication and remember that there is no rush to provide your child with a phone! Children in Class 6 are able to bring a phone to school if they are walking on their own. These are than kept in Mr Swiggs' drawer during the day.

Internet and Phone lines

Our internet and phone lines are still restricted. This is being remedied. In the mean time, we are able to access emails addressed to office and head but class teachers are unable to access emails during the school day. Our mobile phone is acting as the main school phone but this does not have an answer phone facility. Apologies for any inconvenience this has caused.
