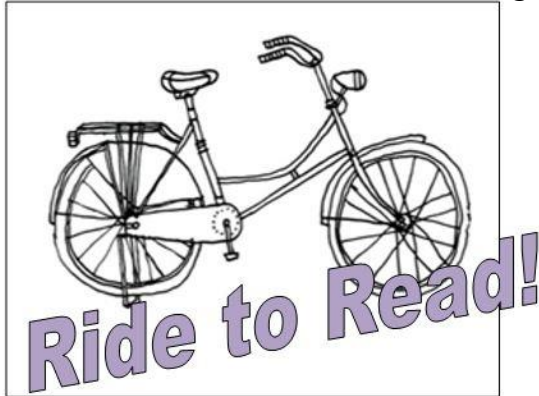
Thanks to Bash Street Theatre
