Learning Out and About and In School

National Poetry Day - We will be celebrating NPD tomorrow with a poetry themed assembly and exploration of poems throughout the day.

Class 1 Science Walk - Class 1 will be heading out on Thursday 1st of October on a nature walk around the school and Swanpool lake looking at different plants growing locally.

Dyslexia Week - Next week is Dyslexia Week and the focus is all about what dyslexia creates. Dyslexia creates artists, entrepreneurs and game changers, but we know that it also creates challenges. We will have an assembly to come together to learn about dyslexia and the positive impact dyslexia creates.

Reception Adventure Club - Our Reception pupils will be off on an adventure to our school field, becoming nature explorers and making dens during the morning of Tuesday 6th October.

Class 1 Allotment Walk - On Thursday 8th of October, Class 1 will be heading off site for a walk around the allotments, looking at the different plants that are growing.

#HelloYellow day - On Friday the 9th of October our School Parliament have decided to support the Hello Yellow campaign to raise awareness and funds to support young people's mental health on World Mental Health Day. Pupils can come to school wearing yellow. We will share details of how to donate money nearer the time.

Class 6 Adventure Club - On Tuesday 13th October our Year 6 pupils will be adventuring in Tregoniggie Woods carrying out a maths orienteering challenge.

Class 1 Falmouth Art Gallery Visit - On Thursday 15th of October Class 1 will be walking down to Falmouth Art Gallery, studying the exhibition and taking part in an art workshop. The gallery will be closed to the general public.

Singing Sessions – After taking part in Covid safety training we are excited to start singing with Jade Stuart-Tribe again. Jade will be developing singing with Class 6 over the next few weeks, focusing on songs from World War 2. Groups will be no bigger than 15 pupils and singing will take place outside.

Covid Updates

Change to Reception and Class 1 Collection: Many thanks to the Reception parents and carers for adapting to the new changes during collection time. The children are now dismissed from the lower playground (at the right of the school entrance.) The Class 1 parents and carers can now wait for their children outside the classroom and spread themselves into the wooded area, along the path or in the pagoda. On Fridays the reception children will follow the Year 6 pupils leaving and will be out just after 2pm.

Please let us know of any improvements you think we could make to keep the school site safe and calm.

Contingency Plan: We have plans in place in case a class bubble, bubbles or the whole school needs to remain at home due to a positive Covid-19 result. This plan will be sent out to all parents next week but essentially, in order to ensure continuity, class teachers and teaching assistants will support your child's learning through daily contact via virtual meetings and learning platforms.
