Home Learning - Spelling Shed and Times Table Rockstars

Children in Classes 2 to 6 should have their Spelling Shed and Times Table Rock Stars logins in their Reading Record books. The children get time to practise these key skills in school but any additional practise is greatly beneficial. If you do not want your children using technology at home, you can access the spelling list on our website: <u>Marlborough Spelling Page</u> where you can work on these in your own way. Times tables can be practised through song, repetition and by displaying and using them at home.

School Attendance

Reporting Illness – If your child is unable to come to school please let the office know by email or by leaving a message on the school answer phone. If we do not have a reason for absence the office will call you but this is obviously time consuming. Thank you.

Exceptional Leave Request – If you need to take your child out of school for any situation other than illness, please ask Olivia for an Exceptional Leave Request form. Some circumstances can be authorised by the school where situations are unavoidable. Please note that holidays taken in term time will be counted as unauthorised.

Education Welfare Officer Support – We monitor attendance daily. When school attendance falls below a certain point or is concerning, our EWO, Alison McGee-Harrison, supports families to improve attendance.

School Site Development

Having carried out a site survery, the Local Authority are funding a new school perimeter fence. Building work is expected to start on the 9th of October and, initially, the team are taking down the wooden fence around Reception and Classes 1 and 2. This will then be replaced with a green metal fence. Whilst the work is taking place the younger classes will not be able to access the wooded area. We are hoping this will not take longer than two school weeks. The builders will then start putting in the fencing in the top playground. For maximum safety, the fence will also enclose the top car park.

Starting School 2024 and Transfer to Secondary School 2024

If your child is starting school in September you can contact the office for a tour of Marlborough. The deadline for applications is 15th January.
