Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had meetings this week with both the Local Authority Attendance Officer and our Education Welfare Officer. As a whole school, our attendance has been affected by illnesses and now chicken pox seems to be doing the rounds. Our average percentage figure is now at 93%, which is low in comparison with other Cornish schools. We currently have 35 children with attendance below 90%. Please be vigilant with your child's attendance over the rest of the term; if your child is not feeling 100% send them in to school and we will keep a close eye on them and call you if they are unwell. As always, holidays and days out are unauthorised. From September the government are cracking down on school attendance and our Governors will be amending our attendance policy in line with the new regulations.
