Mini Pots of Care is a creative and educational fundraising activity for schools and groups.

Every child in the school received their own pot and daffodil bulb to **plant** on Wednesday 11th November. The Charity Group helped each Packet Ship to successfully plant their bulbs. Children learn how to care for their growing shoots until they blossom into beautiful daffodils in spring. They will celebrate their blooms on **Mini Pots of Care Day** in February, 2012, by **painting** their pot wrappers, **learning** about the work of Marie Curie Nurses and **fundraising**.

As part of the fundraising activity each child will be asked to take home a donation envelope, in February, to help raise money for Marie Curie Cancer Care. Please ensure all details are completed and form is returned so that Marie Curie Cancer Care can claim gift aid on your generous donations.
