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Dear Parents

I wrote recently with information concerning the campaign against school cuts. This has stepped up as heads from a number of authorities have identified that specific pressures impact more distinctly on their schools. I've posted a copy of a letter sent by school leaders from every special, primary and secondary school in West Sussex, East Sussex, Essex and Cornwall to their local members of parliament, on the school website News page. If you wish to add your voice to the concerns many people are expressing to politicians you can write to Sarah Newton at, Office 7, The Palace Buildings, Quay Street, Truro, Cornwall, TR1 2HE or by email at sarah.newton.mp@parliament.uk. The letter is detailed and the issue complicated, but it would be great if as many parents as possible wrote to the hope is that parents also ask their MP to:

- ensure that she only votes in support of a new National Funding Formula that ensures minimum adequate funding for every school.
- confirm that a new National Funding Formula must not be considered in isolation from unfunded cost burdens such as increased pension costs, national insurance, inflation and reasonable wage costs.
- ensure that any spending initiatives by the DfE are both credible and provide best value for money.
