'Have Fun for Theo' this Summer

Theo Ward, little brother of Evie-Mai, is currently undergoing treatment for a tumour in his eye. James and Lisa, Theo and Evie-Mai's parents, have written Theo's story for us:

In May 2015 our son Theo (2) was diagnosed with having a tumour in his left eye socket, this has now been confirmed as a Rhabdomyosarcoma. This type of cancer develops in the supporting tissues of the body; Theo's is in the muscle of the eye.

This is a rare type of tumour that effects less than 60 people per year in the UK with most being under the age of 10.

Theo is currently having chemotherapy, which involves frequent stays in hospital; he has already had to have a blood transfusion due to the drugs they are having to use.

Theo's tumour cannot be operated on due to its location; therefore there is a huge possibility of us having to go to America for Proton Beam Therapy. We are still uncertain if this will be funded by the NHS.
