Dear Parents

Many of you will by now have heard of the Let Our Kids be Kids Campaign. I am very grateful for the notice that those people who have chosen to take part have given me, and particularly for the polite and supportive manner in which they have done so. It is clear that they have acted with the best interests of their own and specific children at heart. Others have explained with equal courtesy and concern that they will not be withdrawing children from school tomorrow Tuesday, 3rd May 2016 – again in consideration of the needs of their children. It may not, for example, be appropriate for those who do have tests this year to miss out on any preparation opportunities. Whatever everyone's personal opinion and individual choice, I know that you will have given the matter serious thought and I would like to ask that the whole school community maintains total respect for each other's decisions. I have given the matter much thought and whilst I cannot condone (and should not therefore authorise) withdrawing children voluntarily from school, I find it even more difficult to condone the chaotic organisation and condescending manner currently leading the DfE. Should you have chosen to support the action of the Let Our Kids be Kids Campaign, have notified the school beforehand and are able to provide evidence that your children join in the learning activities alongside the protest, the school will record the absence as a 'C' (exceptional personal circumstances).
