Dear Parents and Carers,

We have come back to school after a breezy and stormy break to a half term which seems like it will be a rollercoaster for us as a community. The children have happily returned to school, they are ready to learn, they are excited by the opportunites given to them in school, the creative curriculum is continuing as planned and we are going to do everything we can to maintain the positive learning environment for all children. As the country goes into a second lockdown period, Marlborough School is remaining fully open in line with national guidance. We have yet to receive guidance specifically for schools but we are pre-empting changes and tightening systems to support the updated lockdown rules. Below are changes that we are having to put into place until this lockdown period has ended.

#### **Covid Updates and Changes**

- Please can Reception pupils be collected at 1.50pm on Fridays to avoid congestion in the lower playground. Thank you.
- There will be no Monday karate club or the Friday multisports clubs until the end of this lockdown period. Other Multisports clubs will go ahead as they are in single year group bubbles.
- All planned outcomes at the end of topics are having to be delivered differently. Class teachers will contact parents to let them know how learning will be shared.
- Please can only one adult come on to the school site for drop off and collection. As we have vulnerable adults bringing their children on to the school site please can adults avoid congregating on pathways inside and outside of school.
- Tours of the school for new reception pupils will not be able to take place.

## **Covid Cases, Symptoms and Testing**

We have one pupil who has tested positive for Coronavirus after experiencing mild symptoms and is now recovering well. The pupil was not in school during the two days prior to symptoms occurring, and did not see anybody from Marlborough School during the half term break. As a result, Public Health England have advised us that we do not need to close the bubble.

Please can we ask parents to keep communicating with us regarding symptoms, isolation, track and trace app isolation and testing. If a member of your household shows symptoms of Covid then the whole household need to isolate. Please do not send your child to school if someone in your household has symptoms.

## **Remote Learning**

As part of our Contingency Plan, teachers are ready to support home learning should we need it. We have plans in place in case pupils need to remain at home due to a positive Covid-19 result. You can find the plan on our website by following this link:

Essentially, in order to ensure continuity, class teachers and teaching assistants will support your child's learning through daily contact via virtual meetings, emails and learning platforms. The government have raised the expectation that if a child is isolating and is still well that they should be working for the whole school day, following a similar timetable to the one offered in schools (and they want this to happen without any added pressure on parents, staff or pupils!) At the moment teaching staff are managing these duel roles on top of their working day, however if we have a rise in the number of children isolating due to Covid-19 then this role may be managed by teaching assistants out of their normal class time.
