Dear Parents

The autumn term has certainly begun with some autumnal weather but that hasn't stopped the children from enjoying their first access to the new outdoor space alongside the infant classrooms. There is a little more to do in this area, tidying up the edges and we would appreciate some help from volunteers able to assist in moving some of the paving and pallets etc. We will put a timetable together shortly and ask parents who wish to help to sign up. We will also arrange a planting session to complete the new borders. Until the greenery is established, please make sure when entering this area to use the pathways provided. Class 1 parents can use the covered waiting shelter and reception class parents should meet children on the brown 'tiger-mulch' space beside the 'scramble stack'.



We'd like to welcome the new families to the school. This is an exciting time for the children and an emotional one for parents. We hope that you too quickly make new and lasting friends and that, if you are unsure of anything, you feel able to ask.

The term begins as usual with an open learning week for the children to plan topic ideas with teachers and to help prepare the classroom to reflect current studies. There will also be a few changes ahead as we aim to improve our service for children and families. One theme of the pre-term staff training days focused on making learning easier and this has returned some of our professional thinking back to the 5 Rs that have underpinned the school's aims for years, but which would benefit from a boost and, with some adjustments will help to support children's understanding more obviously. This, along with many of the practical steps we are taking, will form a central part of the meetings we have planned for you in the meetings with new class teachers. Please be sure to highlight the following dates in your diaries – it is no exaggeration to say that children perform better when their families know what is going on and understand how they can help and these meetings are a sure way to support you. There will be a crèche on each evening:
