

Learning Out and About and in School

VC Class 5 Surf Day – Class 5 are off to Gwithian to spend the day testing their resilience with surfing, provided by Global Boarders, on Friday 28th of June. They will need to be in school early at 8.15am and they will be back later than normal at 4.15pm.
