We now have the exciting challenge of writing our Curriculum Intent document based upon the information gathered from all stakeholders; pupils, parents, staff and governors.

## **Phonics Screening Check**

Pupils in Year 1 and some pupils in Year 2 will be taking part in the Phonics Screening Check this week. The PSC consists of an individual short reading session with the class teacher decoding alien and real words. The pupils have been using these techniques in their everyday learning and will be able to do their best in a fun and supportive environment. The results of the PSC will be sent home alongside the end of year report.

A Midsummer Night's Party- We are planning a whole school production of A *Midsummer Night's Dream* to be performed on the school field on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> of July. We will be working with practitioners from The Minack and Cscape Dance Company to create a play in a week! The Mariners are supporting this project and are planning how to make this event a fun evening for all. Rockpool Explorers-Year 1 pupils will be heading to Gyllyngvase Beach for a rockpool exploration afternoon on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June. They will be eating lunch at school as normal.


