We are incredibly lucky to have **Marlborough Kitchen** serving our children delicious and nutritious meals every day. Ruth, Kay, Cheryl and Amanda are absolutely amazing. In order to make our kitchen sustainable we need customers; we need junior children to choose school dinner options as often as possible! The kitchen needs to cook lunches to order, ensuring that there is no unnecessary waste. As you are all aware with your own bin and recycling collections, food waste is now being collected separately. As a business, we pay for our food waste to be taken off site and we want to reduce this as much as possible.

#### This term, in order to help us reduce food waste:

- Pupils in Reception, Class 1 and Class 2 will be able to bring in a packed lunch. Please remember that we are a **nut free school**. Packed lunches need to be healthy. All food waste and wrapping will be sent home in the child's packed lunch box.
