The Role of the Parent Representative

We aim for each class to have two representatives who serve for two terms, staggered for continuity. This means that if you can't be a representative now, you might like to volunteer later in the year. We communicate with each other and the rest of the members of the class and between classes. Representatives:

- attend meetings about school events
- communicate with each other and with all other members of the group
- disseminate information to the class they represent
- maintain and use the parent contact list
- act as a point of contact
- some representatives choose to assist in co-ordinating events
